

LICENSE TO CARE PILOT

POLICY TRAINING

- Project Core team (City Lead, Faculty Lead, RiR, RA) to draft an initial L2C policy based on current policy knowledge and evidence
- Prepare policy review training materials, and quandary-specific conversation starters (RA)
- Recruit and train 8 student facilitators and note-takers

RESEARCH CABARET

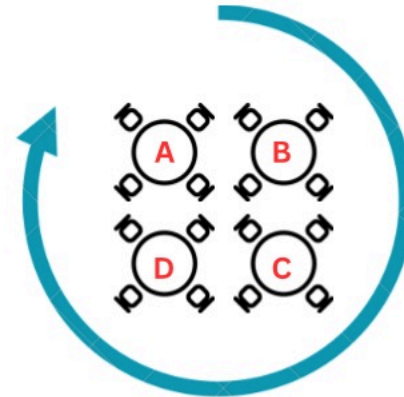
- Interested faculty, students, organizations, and residents participate in a "research cabaret"
- Participants communicate their interest, share their experiences, and build project ideas
- Facilitators and note-takers will remain at each table while participants move through tables every 15-20 minutes
- Ends with a summary from each table and open invitation to join Pilot Teams
- Pilot Teams refine their engagement ideas for "coffee chats" organized by residents

L2C COFFEE CHATS

- Team summaries will be presented and matched with interested neighbourhoods at a S&S meeting
- Teams join coffee chats at matched neighbourhoods
- RA will supply traveling exhibits as conversation starters

KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE

- Core team will reformulate L2C policy based on input from coffee chats and organize a knowledge exchange exhibition for broader engagement
- Roundtables with Pilot Teams and City staff to adopt L2C as a program to facilitate future enactments of the "Caring Neighbourhood"
